Are lithium-ion battery prices falling?

The price of lithium-ion battery cells declined by 97% in the last three decades. A battery with a capacity of one kilowatt-hour that cost \$7500 in 1991 was just \$181 in 2018. That's 41 times less. What's promising is that prices are still falling steeply: the cost halved between 2014 and 2018. A halving in only four years.

How much does a lithium ion battery cost?

The account requires an annual contract and will renew after one year to the regular list price. The cost of lithium-ion batteries per kWh decreased by 14 percent between 2022 and 2023. Lithium-ion battery price was about 139 U.S. dollars per kWh in 2023.

How much does a car battery cost?

At our 2018 price, the battery costs around \$7,300. Imagine trying to buy the same model in 1991: the battery alone would cost \$300,000. Or take the Tesla Model S 75D, which has a 75 kWh battery. In 2018 the battery costs around \$13,600; in 1991, it would have been \$564,000. More than half a million dollars for a car battery.

Will battery pack prices drop again next year?

Given this, BNEF expects average battery pack prices to drop again next year, reaching \$133/kWh (in real 2023 dollars). Technological innovation and manufacturing improvement should drive further declines in battery pack prices in the coming years, to \$113/kWh in 2025 and \$80/kWh in 2030.

What happened to battery metal prices in 2022?

Turmoil in battery metal markets led the cost of Li-ion battery packs to increase for the first time in 2022, with prices rising to 7% higher than in 2021. However, the price of all key battery metals dropped during 2023, with cobalt, graphite and manganese prices falling to lower than their 2015-2020 average by the end of 2023.

New data shows that electric vehicle (EV) battery prices dropped substantially in the fifteen-year period running through last year, representing a reduction of around 90 percent total.

A new study by Prof. Jessika Trancik and postdoctoral associate Micah Ziegler examining the plunge in lithium-ion battery costs finds that "every time output doubles, as it did five times between 2006 and 2016, ...
