



Belgian battery project tender announcement

Is totalenergies developing a second battery storage project in Belgium?

Antwerp, April 3, 2024 - On the occasion of Belgian Energy Minister Tinne Van der Straeten's visit to TotalEnergies' Antwerp refinery battery storage project, the Company announced the development in Belgium of a second similar project. The new project will be developed on the site of TotalEnergies' depot in Feluy.

Who won a capacity market auction in Belgium?

Image: Tinne Van der Straeten via Twitter. New-build battery storage projects from three developers totalling 357MW were among resources awarded contracts in Belgium's latest capacity market auction. Belgian grid operator Elia announced the results of its Capacity Remuneration Mechanism (CRM) auction just before the end of October.

When will totalenergies start-up in Belgium?

Start-up is expected at the end of 2025. These two projects, which represent a global investment of nearly EUR70 million, will bring TotalEnergies' storage capacity in Belgium to 50 MW /150 MWh. These battery storage sites play a key role in the resilience of the electricity system, providing flexibility and helping solve grid congestion problems.

What is Feluy's new lithium-ion project?

The new project will be developed on the site of TotalEnergies' depot in Feluy. It will have a power rating of 25 MW and capacity of 75 MWh, thanks to the forty Intensium Max High Energy lithium-ion containers supplied by Saft. Start-up is expected at the end of 2025.

Who won a wind farm contract in Belgium?

Developers awarded new-build contracts were Storm, a Belgian wind farm developer diversifying into the new technology, which won three contracts of 60MW, 120MW and 25.2MW; Electrabel, a Belgian subsidiary of ENGIE which won two contracts of 55.51MW each; and Innotech, an electricity and heating services provider which won 40.8MW.

Who is totalenergies in Belgium?

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In the 2024 Y-1 auction, one battery project secured a one-year contract, competing mainly against gas-fired OCGTs and CCGTs. Elia publishes the auction rules -- ...

Among others, the project in Ruien (Kluisbergen, East Flanders) concerning a large battery system of 25 MW and 100 MWh was selected. The Capacity Mechanism was created to support new investments in capacity with a view to the - as yet - planned nuclear phase-out in 2025. The aim is to build 2,300 MWe of new gas-fired power plants by 2025 to ...

ENGIE will complete the project in two phases: 100 MW by September 2025 and another 100 MW by January 2026. Additionally, ENGIE has a 15-year contract with Elia, the national grid operator, for this project. ENGIE is also developing two other BESS projects in Belgium: Kallo (100 MW / 400 MWh) and Drogenbos (80 MW / 320 MWh).

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
