How do I know if my Android phone has a battery?

Instead, they display a battery icon, and you are expected to estimate how much is left based on how full it is. However, the exact battery life is displayed on the Lock screen while your Android device is charging, as seen below. Depending on the device you're using, this info might be displayed somewhere else on your Android's screen.

How do I hide the battery percentage on my Android phone?

To hide the battery percentage in the future, toggle off the "Show Battery Percentage" option. And that's it. Your phone now displays the current battery levels in the screen's top-right corner. And that's all there is to adding (and removing) the battery percentage option on your Android phone's status bar.

How to show battery percentage on Android?

You'll customize the status bar (the bar at the top of your phone's screen) so it displays the battery option. On the "Status Bar" page, turn on the "Show Battery Percentage" option. To hide the battery percentage in the future, toggle off the "Show Battery Percentage" option. And that's it.

How to show battery percentage on Samsung Galaxy?

The battery percentage is immediately shown on your status bar. TIP: To get to the setting faster, simply open Settings and use the Search option.

How do I turn off battery percentage on a Pixel phone?

If you use a Pixel phone, then first, launch the Settings app on your phone. In Settings, tap "Battery." Then turn on the "Battery Percentage" option. You now have your phone's current battery levels shown in your screen's top-right corner. Later, you can hide the percentage by toggling off the "Battery Percentage" option.

The remaining battery percentage is not displayed in the status bar. It is recommended that you go to Settings > Battery and toggle on the Show battery percentage switch, or set Battery ...

The remaining battery percentage is not displayed in the status bar.
