Where is Fiji's Navula battery located?

Located on the western side of Viti Levu, the site is one of six gun batteries installed during the Second World War, to protect Fiji against possible invasion by the Japanese. With stunning views out to the Malolo Barrier Reef and the Mamanuca Islands, the site overlooks the Navula passage.

What to do in Fiji?

For history buffs, the Momi Bay Historical Park, commonly known as the Momi Gun Site, should be on your must visit list. Located on the western side of Viti Levu, the site is one of six gun batteries installed during the Second World War, to protect Fiji against possible invasion by the Japanese.

Why did Fiji close a military site?

It was to be the final time the guns were actively used during the course of the war. In February the site was closed due to the retreat of Japanese forces from the Pacific after their loss at the Battle of Guadalcanal in the Solomon Islands. The site was restored by the National Trust of Fiji and officially opened on 24 August.

How did Fiji build 6 inch guns?

In October 1940 the soldiers of the Fiji Defence Force started preparing sites for the 6-inch guns with the help of the Public Works Department and locals from the Momi area. A bulldozer was used to stabilise the foundation and the gun platforms were strategically placed on key positions on the hill.

It was close to a deep water passage and the strategically important airstrips at Nadi and the port of Lautoka.

Not too far from Nasonini gun battery is the Veiuto site, located on a hill on Vuya Road, within the premises of the former Parliament House. One historical account suggested that in December 1939 guns for Suva's battery sites were brought into Fiji from Britain on the naval warship, HMS Leander.

The Momi Battery Historical Park is about a 45-minute drive from Nadi, a city on Fiji's main island in The South Pacific. Construction of the Momi Bay Battery began in May 1940 at the select top hill area overlooked the Navula Passage with primal objective to prevent a Japanese invasion of the island and equipped with 6-inch naval guns.
