How to add a battery to a basin cabinet

How do I install a basin on a wall-mounted vanity unit?

To install a basin onto a wall-mounted vanity unit, the first step is to identify the desired placement of the basin and mark the corresponding position on the wall. Once the position has been determined, measure the centre of the basin to the nearest pipe to ensure proper connection of the water supply and waste pipes to the basin.

How do I install a basin support shelf?

Place and fix base unit into position (see fig 1). When fitting the basin support shelf always make sure the white side is facing upwards and the small cut out is to the front of the unit as the overflow on the basin is at the front. Place the basin into the support shelf, which will need to be adjusted to level the basin with the unit (see fig 5).

How do I install a gable basin?

Place the basin into the shelf apply a bead of silicone to the top face of the basin and to the top of the gable ends (fig 7). We suggest fitting your tap to the worktop before placing the worktop on top of the unit and wipe clean any excess silicon as required.

How do you install a freestanding basin?

For a freestanding basin, ensure that the waste pipe is positioned to easily connect to the drain. Then, drill pilot holes and attach the basin to the wall using mounting screws and fixtures. Use a spirit level to ensure that the basin will be mounted level. Finally, after attaching the basin to the wall, connect the plumbing and check for leaks.

How do I re-fit a basin & tap?

Pull the cabinet into the wall. Once unit has been adjusted level the basin and taps can be fitted. Fit 2 stretcher brackets equally spaced (see fig 4) to the rear of the unit, level brackets with the gable ends which will support the rear of the basin when fitted. Re-fit drawer boxes starting with the push to open first.

How do I choose a bathroom basin?

Determine the size of the basin: Measure the width, depth, and height of the basin that you plan to install. Make sure the basin fits comfortably within the available space. Consider the clearance: Consider the clearance between the basin and any obstacles, such as the wall or other fixtures.

For depth, reference the basin height and add 6 to 12 inches. Fill the pit with 6 to 12 inches of gravel. Before installing the basin, we recommend wrapping it in filter fabric or landscaping fabric. The fabric protects the basin from dirt, grime and other particulates from entering the basin and ensures proper pump functioning.
