

How to disassemble the capacitive pen battery

How do you replace a battery on a Surface Pen?

1. Pull the top end straight out from the bottom. 2. Replace the AAAA battery with the positive (+) end of the battery pointing toward the tail end of the pen. 3. Align the flat sides of the pen and push the two parts back together. Surface Pen with single button on flat edge 1.

How do you remove a battery from a pen?

How do you put a pen in a battery?

Pull the top of the pen away from the body of the Pen (you may have to use some force). Pull out the AAAA battery from the body of the Pen. Place the negative end of the AAAA battery into the body of the Pen (the negative end will be marked with a minus sign [-]). Slot the top of the pen back into the body of the Pen.
