How do I ship a lithium battery?

Ensure the country you want to ship to accepts lithium batteries. Check online and look at the shipping policy for lithium batteries for your country. Some areas may restrict you from sending lithium batteries entirely, while others will put limitations on the types of batteries you can send.

Can I send a lithium battery through the post office?

If you're sending lithium metal batteries, then make sure each battery doesn't contain more than 2 g of lithium. You cannot send lithium batteries more than 2 batteries or 4 battery cells through the post office. Use another shipping service for batteries labeled as dangerous goods.

Lithium Battery - The term "lithium battery" refers to a family of batteries with different chemistries, comprising many types of cathodes and electrolytes. For the purposes of the DGR they are separated into: Lithium metal batteries. Are generally primary (non-rechargeable) batteries that have lithium metal or lithium compounds as an anode.

Call the shipping service ahead of time to see if they have any special regulations or rules about shipping lithium batteries. You may need to pay a surcharge for shipping dangerous goods, but the fee may be anywhere between \$50-100 USD. Fill out a declaration for dangerous goods for loose or large batteries.

Can I ship a lithium ion battery by air?

For this reason, any battery that is suspected or known to be defective (swelling, corroding or leaking, for example) is not permitted for shipping within the DHL Express network.
