

How to remove the battery board of the tablet interface

How do you remove a battery from a Samsung tablet?

Find the battery connector, usually located near the top edge of the battery. Use the plastic spudger to gently lift and disconnect the connector. Note: Be careful not to bend or damage the connector pins. With the battery connector disconnected, the battery should now be removable. Gently lift it from the tablet, working your way around the edges.

How do I remove a laptop battery?

Detach the hinge frame at the left end, turn the hinge frame clockwise around its right end so as to steer the battery FPC out through the supporting frame at the right end, and then remove the hinge frame from the main body of the tablet.
