



# North Korea Special Battery Procurement Project

The Korean government will provide 38 trillion won (US\$29 billion) in financial support, including expanding loan limits and debt guarantees for the Korean secondary battery industry over five years. A separate bill will also be prepared to support the growth of a used battery industry ecosystem.

SK On signs a three-year agreement with POSCO Pilbara Lithium Solution for up to 15,000 tons of lithium hydroxide. The company secures a key raw material supply in Korea for NCM cathodes, enhancing market responsiveness.

The supplier's warranty is a key provision of any equipment procurement agreement.
