

Why is capital big battery delayed until 2024?

Neoen says Capital Big Battery delayed until 2024 due to connection issues, with liquidated damages to be paid in a likely first-of-its type case for battery storage projects in Australia.

When will a capital battery be in production?

Construction of the 100MW, two hour (200 MWh) Capital battery, located near the Queanbeyan sub-station, was finished earlier this year, and the photo above was published by the EPC contractor Doosan Gridtech in March. A video posted on the project website, also in March, said the battery was expected to be in production before the end of June.
