How much does a battery cost in 2022?

In 2022, the estimated average battery price stood at about USD 150 per kWh, with the cost of pack manufacturing accounting for about 20% of total battery cost, compared to more than 30% a decade earlier. Pack production costs have continued to decrease over time, down 5% in 2022 compared to the previous year.

What happened to battery metal prices in 2022?

Turmoil in battery metal markets led the cost of Li-ion battery packs to increase for the first time in 2022, with prices rising to 7% higher than in 2021. However, the price of all key battery metals dropped during 2023, with cobalt, graphite and manganese prices falling to lower than their 2015-2020 average by the end of 2023.

How much does a battery electric vehicle cost in 2022?

For battery electric vehicle (BEV) packs in particular, prices were \$138/kWh on a volume-weighted average basis in 2022. At the cell level, average BEV prices were just \$115/kWh. This indicates that on average, cells account for 83% of the total pack price.

How much does a battery cost in 2024?

Global manufacturing capacity for battery cells now totals 3.1 TWh, which is more than 2.5 times the annual demand for lithium-ion batteries in 2024, BNEF says. In early summer 2023, publicly available prices ranged from 0.8 to 0.9 RMB/Wh (\$0.11 to \$0.13 USD/Wh), or about \$110 to 130/kWh. Pricing initially fell by about a third by the end of summer 2023. Now, as reported by CnEVPost, large EV battery buyers are acquiring cells at 0.4 RMB/Wh, representing a price decline of 50% to 56%.
