



# Vietnam energy storage battery project starts

Is a battery energy storage system coming to Vietnam?

15 October 2021 - Vietnam's pilot utility-scale battery energy storage system [BESS] will soon take shape in Khanh Hoa Province after an agreement was signed today between AMI AC Renewables and the U.S. Consulate in Ho Chi Minh City to formalize a US\$2,962,000 grant from the latter to develop the project.

How can a battery energy storage system improve Vietnam's grid stability?

During the workshop, a report titled "Enhancing Vietnam's Grid Stability with BESS," co-authored by the Institute of Energy (IE) and GEAPP, was launched. Scaling battery energy storage systems is critical in ensuring a steady supply of renewable energy for the communities that need it most.

What is battery energy storage system (BESS)?

Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) play a pivotal role in addressing these challenges by minimising the intermittency of renewables, enhancing grid flexibility, and ensuring reliable power supply. In a significant development, Vietnam Electricity (EVN) has secured approval for its first pilot BESS project with a capacity of 50 MW/50MWh.

EVN's 50 MW Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) pilot project, in collaboration with ADB and GEAPP, aims for 300 MW by 2030. Vietnam is the fastest-growing energy market in Asia, according to the International Trade Administration.

The joint venture is collaborating with Honeywell to integrate Vietnam's first grid-connected battery energy storage system (BESS) project in the 50 MWp Khanh Hoa Solar plant; The project aims to demonstrate the commercial viability, reliability and efficiency of battery energy storage in Vietnam

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Vietnam's REA and GEAPP hosted a workshop on integrating battery energy storage systems into Vietnam's power grid, where they also launched a report on battery storage co-authored by the Institute of Energy and GEAPP.

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American conglomerate Honeywell and AMI AC Renewables will receive another US\$3 million grant from the US government to pursue a battery energy storage system (BESS) project in Vietnam.

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Currently, GEAPP is testing a battery energy storage system that integrates with the national grid for the first time, in collaboration with the Asian Development Bank, Rocky Mountain Institute, and the Vietnam Energy Institute (VEI).

In September, solar and storage EPC and O& M provider Borrego selected Gotion High-Tech as a supplier of DC-block battery storage equipment for projects in the US, with deliveries scheduled to begin next year. Meanwhile, in Vietnam, the market for battery energy storage systems (BESS) has yet to take off.

The power plant will be the first in Vietnam to deploy the Battery Energy Storage System. Nguyen Nam Thang, CEO of AMIAC Renewables, said at the signing ceremony there was a determination to put the project into operation before the third quarter of 2024.
