Who makes lithium ion batteries in China?

Tianjin Lishen is by far the largest investment and highest technology level lithium ion battery producer in China, with a stable market share among the top five in the world, and has become a representative brand of lithium ion battery in China. Since 2015, China surpassed Japan, Korea, and the rest of the world and became the largest exporter of lithium batteries. Combined with Japan and Korea, the countries account for 95% of lithium battery production in the world. China has the fourth-largest known lithium reserve with 1 million tons, behind Chile, Australia, and Argentina.

From 2001 to 2008, early players like BYD, Shenzhen Bike Battery, and Tianjin Lishen Battery have grown their investments in battery research and brought growth to the Chinese lithium battery industry. Does China own lithium?

China continues to buy stakes in mining operations around the world. The world's largest lithium mine in Australia, Greenbushes, is controlled by China's Tianqi Lithium with its 51% stake. In the decade since 2010, the market capitalization of China's lithium battery has had an average annual growth of 14%.

As a result, it has quickly become the world's largest manufacturer and consumer of rechargeable batteries, powered by a robust network of factories that cater to both domestic and international demand.

As of 2022, it had eight major operational battery factories, concentrated in the Midwest and the South.
